I, as the General Manager of the Political Subdivision, a Municipal Utility District, certify that I have custody of the records of the Political Subdivision and that I am authorized to execute this Order on behalf of the Political Subdivision. I further certify as follows:

1. This Order was duly adopted on the Date of Adoption. The Board of Directors of Brown County Water Improvement District No. 1 convened in a special meeting at 4:00 pm, March 23, 2020, in the office of the District at 501 E. Baker, Brownwood, Texas, in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act. This Order has not been amended, modified, or rescinded and is now in full force and effect.

2. In accordance with the authority vested in the Political Subdivision through the proclamation issued by Governor Greg Abbot, as discussed in Election Advisory No. 2020-12 from Keith Ingram, Director of Elections, the Political Subdivision hereby exercises such authority and orders as follows:

ORDERED, that, the Political Subdivision's Director Election is postponed from the May 2, 2020 uniform election date to the November 3, 2020 election date.

ORDERED FURTHER, that candidate filings for the election will remain valid for the election on November 3, 2020, and the filing period will not be re-opened for the November election date.

ORDERED FURTHER, that all applications for a ballot by mail ("ABBM") for voters that are voting by mail due to being over the age of 65 or due to disability will still be valid for the postponed election, and that ABBMs for voters who submitted ABBMs based on expected absence from the county will not be valid for the postponed election.

ORDERED FURTHER, that the major relevant dates for the November election shall be as follows:

- Voter registration deadline: **October 5, 2020**
- Deadline to submit an ABBM: **October 23, 2020**
- Early voting dates: **October 19, 2020—October 30, 2020**

3. I further certify that the Political Subdivision is duly organized and existing under the laws of the state of Texas, is qualified to do business here, and is in good standing; that there is no provision of the regulations of the Political Subdivision limiting the powers of the general manager or board members to enforce this Order and that the Order is in conformity with the provisions of

the regulations of Political Subdivision; and that the undersigned is the keeper of the records and minutes of the proceedings of the Political Subdivision.
